2005 ECAC Men's East All-Academic Team Announced

Cape Cod, Mass. - The Commissioner of the ECAC, Phil Buttafuoco, is pleased to announce the 2005 ECAC Division III Men's East Ice Hockey All-Academic Team. This marks the third year that the conference has named all-academic teams for its five Division III Hockey Leagues. A total of 35 student-athletes representing all 10 of the Men's East League teams have earned this honor.

To be named to the 2005 ECAC Men's East All-Academic Team, the student-athlete must have completed at least one academic year (at the current institution), must maintain a cumulative grade-point average of at least 3.00 on a 4.00 scale and must have competed in at least one-half of his team's contests during the 2004-05 season (goaltenders must have played at least 33 percent of his team's minutes).
