German w/ English subtitles. A love affair at the height of the war in Berlin, between a Jewish woman concealing her identity from authorities and a German mother whose husband is serving in the army.

Desert Hearts (1985)

An English professor, goes to Reno in 1959 for a quick divorce. She spends the weeks waiting for final divorce papers at a dude ranch, where she meets a young casino worker.

Love story set in New Delhi between two women.
