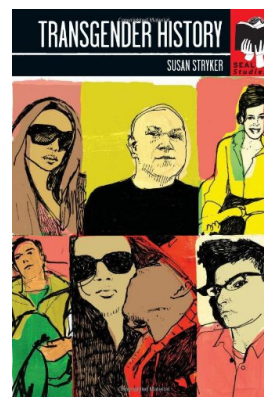

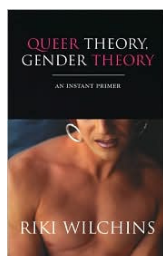

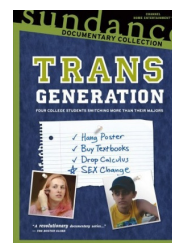
The true story of the tragic death of soldier Barry Winchell, and his love for Calpernia Addams, a transgendered nightclub performer.
