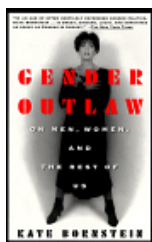

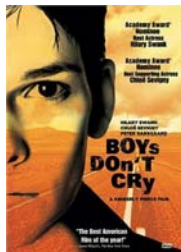

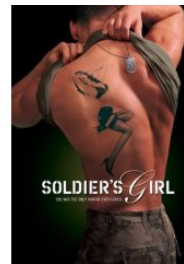
Presents the five female impersonators known as The House of LeMay, based in Burlington, Vermont.
